- The association Lithuanian Social Innovation Cluster (LSIC) was registered on August 28th, 2020 in the Vilnius branch of the State Enterprise Centre of Registers.
- Creation of the Association's email info@lsik.lt, website (www.lsik.lt), Facebook and LinkedIn accounts, cluster's profile on Klaster.lt, ECCP, and Pact for Skills.
- Cluster application for services from MITA project "Promotion and Development of Innovation Networking (INOLINK)" submitted and positively evaluated.
- A tripartite agreement has been signed with MITA and LIC for the provision of services.
- A tripartite agreement was signed between LSIC, ŠMSM, MIA.
- A cooperation agreement has been signed with LiSVA.

- Implementation of human trafficking prevention Innovations in a network organization (meet-ups and a hackathon) - together with VŠĮ Ramintoja.
- Architectural creative workshops – together with VŠĮ Bendrystės ir socialinių inovacijų centras, VŠĮ Ramintoja, and MB Bauland.
- Restoration of Vilnius St. Virgin Maria's Church building in a virtual 3D space – VŠĮ Ramintoja together with VŠĮ Bendrystės ir socialinių inovacijų centras, VŠĮ Robotikos mokykla, and the University of Florence.
- Development of an educational preventive virtual platform (traffic safety virtual escape room, human trafficking simulation situation models) – together with VŠĮ Ramintoja and VŠĮ Robotikos mokykla.

On the 31st of December 2020, the Association had € 2,397 in current assets consisting of € 500 in other receivables and € 1,897 in cash and cash equivalents.

During 2020 the Association did not receive targeted funding and support, only € 2,400 in membership fees, of which € 132 was used. The association did not provide charity and support to others.

Net operating result: during 2020 the Association had no income and costs of 132 €, which were covered by membership fees, so the net operating result is 0 €.
